What's the Problem?

- Shellfish cannot be shipped across state lines without ISSC approval
- ISSC is administered voluntarily by states
- Not all states are participating
- There is no alternate recourse
- Choice: lose sales or violate the law
- Law is virtually ignored by all

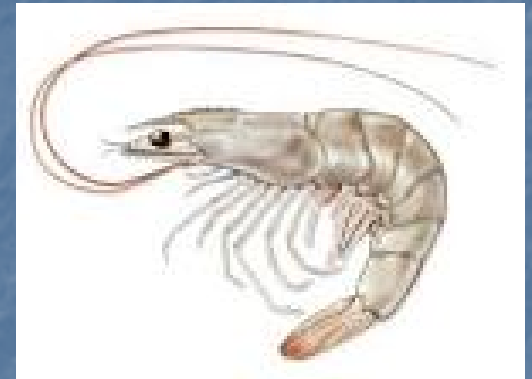
