

Executive Treasurer Report Fall Board Meeting - 2021

Financial Statement

The third quarter of 2021 Conference for Food Protection Financial Report, attached, provides revenues and expenses for the third quarter of 2021. CFP had over \$104,000 in income during the third quarter from primarily Biennial Meeting registrations and the NACCHO/CFP Collaborative. After expenses, CFP's net income for the period was \$15,240.00. I expect to receive payment on the FDA Grant very soon, as well as the payout of the remaining Eventbrite funds noted under Other Assets on the Financial Statement. CFP carried over \$559,000.00 into the fourth quarter and I expect CFP will carry over \$550,000.00 into 2022.

2020 Biennial Meeting Income Statement

The final income report for the 2020 Biennial Meeting reflects a very positive outcome considering the obstacles endured. During the next couple of months, I will be breaking down revenue numbers and comparing them with past meetings. NACCHO/CFP Retail Food Collaborative Grant - Year 1

Attached is the Final Year 1 financial report for the NACCHO / CFP Retail Food Collaborative. The report shows a year 1 net income in the amount of \$95,712.74.

2022-2023 Proposed Conference for Food Protection Budget

Included in this report is a proposed 2022-2023 CFP Budget for your review and approval. All amounts within the budget were derived from historical data. Certain item amounts were adjusted based on upcoming changes and/or inflation. Executive Staff budgeted compensation was increased 7% due to inflation plus a \$3,000 bonus if deemed warranted. Computer/Software expense was increased due to the Wild Apricot adoption, and funds were made available within Website Support to facilitate an update to the website if necessary.
