Deadline: September 15, 2019

The Integrated Foodborne Outbreak Response and Management (InFORM) conference will be held at the Westin Atlanta Peachtree Plaza Hotel March 9–12, 2020. Held every two years, InFORM brings together the network of public health officials involved with foodborne and enteric disease outbreak response. This includes federal, state and local public health scientists, epidemiologists, laboratorians, environmental health specialists, and health communicators.

Abstract Requirements

Submit proposals for posters, sunrise sessions and breakout sessions. Breakout session proposals will include options for single talks or full session proposals for multiple speakers.

All abstract submissions must include a title, author(s) and affiliation(s).

Abstracts should not have been presented at a national conference in the United States within the past year. Abstracts that do not meet format requirements will not be considered for review.
