The Conference for Food Protection (CFP) is collaborating with the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO) on a two-year research project designed to further the capacity of state, local, tribal and territorial (SLTT) food regulatory agencies to improve retail food safety and reduce foodborne illness across the United States. This is a half-time position funded by a grant from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) that CFP is collaborating on with the National Association of County and City Health Officials (NACCHO)..

The salary for the Research Project Support Staff Member is up to \$37,500 per year depending on experience. Funding for the first year of the project is guaranteed. Funding for the position in year two is dependent on receiving funding from FDA for the second year of the project. The Research Project Support Staff member will render services associated with the position as an independent contractor. The individual hired for the position will be responsible for the payment of any self-employment, income, and/or other taxes arising from performance of these services.
