

## CDC UPDATE FOR THE CONFERENCE FOR FOOD PROTECTION

August 21-22, 2018

- The July 27, 2018 MMWR Surveillance Summaries contained “Surveillance for Foodborne Disease Outbreaks – United States, 2009-2015.” Norovirus remains the most common foodborne pathogen followed by *Salmonella*.
- CDC has updated the design of the webpages for updates on multistate outbreaks (<https://www.cdc.gov/foodsafety/outbreaks/multistate-outbreaks/outbreaks-list.html>)
- Hepatitis A outbreaks in multiple states are continuing and are still focused on person-person transmission
  - Vaccination is recommended for homeless and others that use drugs
  - There has been a vaccine shortage but it appears to be clearing
